HOW OPIOID OVERDOSE TAKES LIFE



Opioids are still active in your body after the desired feeling wears off. This is called a "Half-life."



Taking more changes how the brain controls important body systems.



Normal breathing now becomes a labored, thought-based action vs automatic.



Opioids can make you feel drowsy. If you fall asleep, you can stop thinking about breathing.



If breathing stops, so does the heart and your life. This is fatal opioid overdose.

HOW TO STOP AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

1

Spray naloxone in victim's left nostril

2

Call 9-1-1

3

If you are able, give CPR as instructed by 911 dispatch

4

If no reaction after 1 minute... give another dose in other nostril.



Naloxone (NARCAN) is not addictive, not abusable, and only works on opioid overdose. So, when in doubt...SPRAY!
